



### **Terms & Conditions of Entry into the Little Kids Day Out event**

1. The entry into the grounds will constitute an acceptance by the attendee / volunteer / booth holder / activity or vendor provider of these conditions and imply an undertaking on behalf of those entering to observe them. In the event of any breach of these conditions, Little Kids Day Out Committee (LKDOC) reserves the right to ask anyone to leave the event.
2. The LKDOC reserves the right to vary the advertised performers, entertainers and/or program.
3. LKDOC reserves the right with reasonable cause, to refuse admission or remove any person from the event
4. In the case of an emergency follow the directions of event staff.
5. LKDOC reminds parents and guardians that while every care will be taken to provide attendees with a safe environment within the event children attending the Little Kids Day Out event always remain the responsibility of their parents or guardians during their attendance at the event.
6. All children under the age of 14 must be accompanied by an adult.
7. LKDOC takes no responsibility for unaccompanied children and reserves the right to refuse admission to unaccompanied children.
8. All entering must not bring any of the following items into the Little Kids Day Out event.
  - a. Alcoholic beverages
  - b. Prohibited weapons or dangerous goods
  - c. Any items the patron intends to distribute or offer for sale that do not have prior approval.
9. While within the event area, patrons must not:
  - a. Climb any structure (Does not apply to climbing activities)
  - b. Distribute any printed material without prior approval from LKDOC
  - c. Display any banner or poster that the LKDOC does not approve of
  - d. Promote political, religious, racial, or personal views which may be offensive to other attendees
  - e. Use indecent language or behave in an indecent manner
  - f. Smoke within the event area or within 10m of the fence boundary
  - g. Take photos of performers or patrons without their express and prior consent
10. Those entering are invited to bring a picnic lunch and nibbles along with a water bottle. Water stations will be available at the event. There will be a wide variety of refreshments and food available for purchase on site. No sugary drinks will be on sale at the event.
11. I understand that by entering the Little Kids Day Out event I may be filmed, photographed, or taped and this may be used on future promotional materials and advertising. It is deemed that a person by entering the event consents to the LKDOC, or third parties appointed by the LKDOC photographing, filming, or taping. The LKDOC or third parties appointed by the event

can broadcast, publish, licence, and use any photographs, film, recordings or images without compensation. The LKDOC, third parties and anyone acquiring from them a right to use the material are not liable to the subject for its use in any way.

12. By attending and participating in the LKDO event, I hereby state that I have read and understood these LKDO Terms and Conditions and agree to follow them throughout the duration of my event visit.
13. Booth and activity providers and vendors MUST follow the above Terms and Conditions as well as the following
  - a) Setup must be at a time agreed by LKDOC (Friday 12noon-5pm or Saturday 7am-8:30am)
  - b) No movement is allowed on the grass area in front of the pavilion before 9am (due to horses run on the track)
  - c) Once you have unloaded your vehicle park on the grass area to the left of the grandstand
  - d) Entrance to the pavilion Saturday morning will be via the side door until 9am. At 9am this door will then be closed.
  - e) Set up must stay within the allocated area. Standard area is 3mx3m (booth or activity) or 3mx5m (activity and booth) or as otherwise agreed prior to the event.
  - f) Keep all displays safely secured.
  - g) Actively provide feedback to parents/carers regarding the age suitability of their activity.
  - h) Be mindful of small children accessing materials (small, sharp objects which may cause harm)
  - i) Set up finalised Saturday morning before 8:45am and is NOT to be removed until 2pm
  - j) Area must be left clean and tidy with all rubbish removed
  - k) Park in designated parking area for volunteers/vendors/booth & activity providers
  - l) Always maintain a pleasant manner.
  - m) If you are at all concerned about a child's safety, you should act to safeguard the child as a priority. This may require you to speak firmly, but always do so in a kind tone.
  - n) If you find a lost child. Keep the child with you and phone Kim on 0418 157 280
  - o) Body fluid clean-up – Stay at site to protect against slip hazards. Phone Kim for clean-up.
  - p) ALL volunteers and staff MUST use the QR Code below on arrival to confirm entry to the site**
